How to get the COVID-19 Vaccine

1. Check to see if it's your turn. California is giving the vaccine at no cost to different groups of people in a phased approach. Check myturn.ca.gov to see when it's your turn.
2. Schedule an appointment. Find out when it's your turn at MyTurn, the official California state government website or call (833) 422-4355 Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Saturday-Sunday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. to schedule an appointment. You can also sign up to check eligibility and be notified when it's your turn.
3. Find other vaccine providers.
 - Check with pharmacies (see [Pharmacy Resources](#))
 - Check with your local Health Department (see [Quality Resources](#))
