

Use findhelp to Connect Members to Community Supports Services

TO PROMOTE GOOD HEALTH, FIND LOCAL COMMUNITY SUPPORTS PROVIDERS FOR PATIENTS

Community Supports providers are organizations with experience working directly in the community who understand members' needs such as homelessness, unstable and unsafe housing, food insecurity and/or other social needs. The key goal is to provide care to members in locations where they feel most comfortable and keep them in their home or community.

To support the California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal (CalAIM) program implemented by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), California Health & Wellness Plan expanded its partnership with findhelp (formerly known as Aunt Bertha) to support the CalAIM work for our providers.


Follow these steps to create an account and refer a member

Create an account.

- 1 Go to **communitysupportsecm.findhelp.com**.
- 2 Click on **Sign-up** at the top right corner.
- 3 Fill in your information and create a password.

Search and make a referral.

- 1 Log into your account.
- 2 Complete and submit the appropriate CalAIM Assessment – view available Community Supports programs and make a referral; **or**
- 3 Enter a Zip Code and click search.

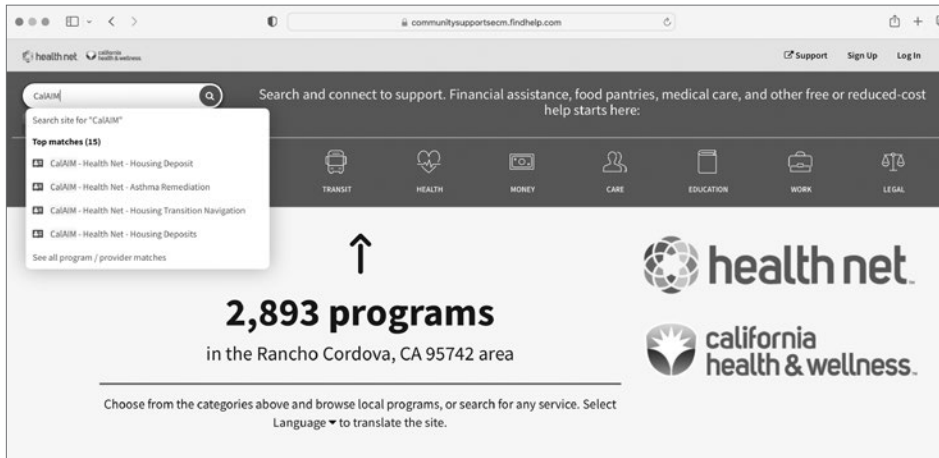
